

Windows 10 – Decision Time

1. Windows 10 will be a free upgrade to existing Windows 7, Windows 8.1 and Windows Phone 8.1 devices that upgrade prior to July 29. Don't wait to the last minute.
1. You can Google "Windows 10 advisor" and select: "[How to Upgrade to Windows 10 - Microsoft](#)". In the footnote at the page bottom, third paragraph, click on "[Windows 10 Specifications page](#)" or search for "See Windows 10 in action" and click on "[Windows 10 Demo - microsoft.com](#)".
2. The Specs:
 - Be sure you have the latest update
 - Processor: 1GHz or faster
 - RAM: 1GB for 32 bit OS, 2GB for 64 bit OS
 - Hard Disc: 16GB for 32 bit OS, 20GB for 64 bit OS
 - Graphics Card: DirectX 9 or later with WDDM 1.0 driver
 - Display: 800x600
3. To check that your computer will accept Windows 10 and what problems may be encountered, click on the "Get Windows 10 app" in the system tray. ☐ This will also allow you to start the installation. If you don't have that symbol, Google "Get Windows 10 app" and click on "[The "Get Windows 10" app doesn't appear in Windows 7 or 8.1](#)"
4. You can right click on the "Get Windows 10 app" to get to 4 options.
5. "Windows Media Center" is replaced by "Windows DVD player" in Windows 10
6. Windows 7 desktop gadgets will be removed in Windows 10
7. Solitaire, Minesweeper, and Hearts Games that come pre-installed on Windows 7 will be removed in Windows 10. Microsoft has released their version of Solitaire and Minesweeper called the "Microsoft Solitaire Collection" and "Microsoft Minesweeper."
8. Windows 10 comes with Windows Defender which is good anti-virus protection. Windows comes with a magnifier. Some programs will magnify/demagnify with ctrl +/-.
9. If you make a file to store your IDs and Passwords on your computer, on Windows 10 click on the box "Save with password" in the "Save As" window when storing the file.
